

## mapped out

With a wealth of storage and abundant space for fun, this playroom is set to grow alongside the family it houses.

Three young boys and all the books, toys, and games that come with them can add up to a lot of stuff. This was the challenge facing Kyle Meidell and Nicole Bavo, who wanted their new house to have plenty of space for both having good times and stashing stuff. So when they hired Mike Rausch and Devin Johnson of Johnson Squared, they prioritized a new basement playroom.

Flexibility was the overarching theme. "The family knew they were going to need a space that could adapt over the years—kids go through different types of toys and games as they get older," Rausch says. "And we wanted to provide storage that could accommodate all those changes."

To make it happen, Johnson Squared created a cozy living space flanked by

an open area currently occupied by a freestanding train table. Built-in shelving keeps books and toys tidy, while an adjacent wall of cabinets disguised by a world map hides games and supplies. "The family travels a lot," Rausch says, "So the treatment is a fun way to document their adventures over the years."

**1.** Cut and glued to cabinets piece by piece, this map mural lets the family reminisce on their travels. **2.** Board games, movies, and puzzles sit at the ready just behind closed doors.

- **3.** A utensil caddy, dishes, and straws stow neatly inside a low drawer, eliminating trips to the kitchen upstairs when snack time rolls around. **4.** Open shelving offers compartments for books, collections, and a few favorite toys.
- **5.** A train table surrounded by comfy poufs serves as the main attraction for the family's young sons. When the boys grow older, the family plans to replace it with a pool table. Concrete floors are a low–maintenance, easy–to–clean solution to kids' messes.
